## DRAFT AMENDMENTS IN THE CONSTITUTION OF RSCWS – PROPOSED IN - 2012

- Approved by the Executive Committee RSCWS in its Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2012 Recommended for adoption in General Body Meeting of RSCWS to be held in April, 2012)

- RSCWS has been working since 1991 for the welfare of the Railway Pensioners and has many achievements to its credit. RSCWS now proposes to expand its activities to various parts of India.
- The Executive Committee RSCWS has approved vital Amendments in the Constitution of RSCWS to give the organisation a Federal Structure with Zones & Branches in various parts of the country and to mobilise Pensioners for joining the struggle for their welfare.
- Suggestions & comments are invited on the following proposed Amendments in the Constitution so that the same be placed before the General Body of RSCWS -for the final approval & adoption thereof, in its Meeting in April, 2012.
