JUDGEMENT OF PUNJAB & HARYANA HC FOR PRE-2006 HARYANA PENSIONERS UPHOLDS MODIFIED PARITY AS RECOMMENDED BY SIXTH CPC

Punjab & Haryana High Court in its Double Bench judgement pronounced on 21-12-2012 has allowed the petition filed by Haryana pensioners retired from S 31 (equivalent to S 29) restoring correct fixation of pension. This is the first judgement in favour of pre-2006 Pensioners from a HIGH COURT.

It may be recalled that Haryana Govt. had deprived pensioners of true modified parity - following so called "Clarificatory" orders of 3rd October, 2008 issued by Govt of India on 6th CPC recommendations.
