Sub: Revised Pension in 7th CPC with Notional Pay in Upgraded Scales of each CPC Concordance Tables for Revision of Pension in case of Upgraded Posts & Clarification required thereof.

Ref: i) DOP&PW OM F.No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A) Dated 6th July, 2017 & 12th May, 2017.

1. We draw your kind attention towards the following vital issue having serious impact on the affected Pensioners in the above cited orders issued by your office which requires to be clarified to avoid undue loss and hardship to the Pre-2016 Pensioners concerned whose posts were upgraded by the Pay Commissions:

i) As per OM dated 12-5-2017, Notional pay relating to 6th CPC has been taken as per the Fitment Tables enclosed with OM dated 30-8-2008 for fixation of Revised Pension w.e.f. 1-1-2016.

ii) Some pay scales were upgraded by 5th, 6th & 7th CPCs but these are not reflected in the Concordance Tables issued vide OM dated 6-7-2017 cited above. These Concordance Tables are not applicable for the upgraded posts.

iii) a) Pay fixation has to be done under Note 2A below Rule 7(1) of CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 by adding higher Grade Pay instead of normal ones.

b) As such, the Notional Fixation of Pay in case of Pre-2006 Pensioners should be based on the same for the purpose of arriving at their Notional Pay in the 7th CPC Pay Matrix and the Revised Pension from 1-1-2016 should be based thereon.

iv) OM 6th July 2017 para 4 reads "*.... In case of any inconsistency in the concordance tables vis-à-vis the relevant instructionsnotional pay may be fixed in accordance with the instructions applicable for fixation of pay in the intervening Pay Commissions also.*"

2. a) It is therefore, requested that necessary clarification in this regard may please be issued that the Revised Pension from 1-1-2016 be determined as per Notional pay for the upgraded pay scales adopted for pay fixation of serving employees in V CPC, VI CPC & VII CPC.

b) Concordance Tables for the Upgraded Posts may please be issued separately, to avoid miscarriage of justice & omissions in this regard.
