2. RSCWS has also presented 4 Air Coolers to Primary School, Railway Colony Chandigarh to save the small children from scorching heat due to small and congested classrooms with low lying asbestos roofs.

3. A Medical Seminar was also held on "Heart Care in Old Age" for the benefit and awareness of the Senior Citizens during the Quarterly Meeting & AGM on 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2018.

4. A detailed Report of Social Welfare activities of RSCWS April 2018 (with photographs) is sent herewith for kind information and for further help from the Railways in the following areas:

5. It is requested that at least two more classrooms be provided by the Railways in the Govt. Primary School, Railway Colony Chandigarh, increasing the size & height of the existing classrooms, providing pucca roofs (*instead of existing asbestos sheets*), besides providing some other essentially required facilities for the children including planting of trees, joy rides & swings in the adjoining Park / Playground.


