### **CONCORDANCE TABLES ISSUED FOR REVISION OF PENSION OF PRE-2016 PENSIONERS AS PER NOTIONAL FIXATION OF PAY FROM CPC TO CPC & FIXATION OF BP AT 50% OF NOTIONAL PAY IN 7<sup>TH</sup> CPC PAY MATRIX**

Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare (DOP & PW) (vide their OM dated 6-7-2017) had issued the Concordance Tables for revision of Pension of Pre-2016 Pensioners w.e.f. 1-1-2016 as per New Formula of Notional Fixation of Pay from CPC to CPC & Fixation of Basic Pension at 50% of Notional Pay as per 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix. DOP & PW has also advised all Ministries to issue Revised PPOs suo-moto without asking for any additional details from Pensioners. [SEE COPIES OF ORDERS ON PAGE 6 & 7]

The demand for issue of Fixation Tables for Revised Pension as per New Formula was strongly raised by RSCWS & BPS, for expeditious revision of Pension and Family Pension & issue of Revised PPOs.

RESTORATION OF OPTION 1 OF 7TH CPC FOR REVISION OF PENSION OF PRE-2016  
PENSIONERS WITH NEW FORMULA AS 3<sup>RD</sup> OPTION**

**Subject: Appeal for restoration of Option 1 recommended by 7<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission for Revision of Pension of Pre-2016 Pensioners - For Parity of Pension between Pre & Post-2016 Central Government Pensioners**

**Reference: i) DOP&PW OM No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A) dated 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 & 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2017**

**ii) Para 10.1.67 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Report for grant of Parity of Pension of Pre & Post Seventh CPC Pensioners**

**1. We draw your kind attention to the sad plight of large majority of Central Government Pensioners – especially the Pre-2006 Pensioners and more so the Pre-1996 Pensioners, who will suffer a major financial loss in fixation of their Revised Pension on account of an unjust decision on implementation of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Report vide DOP&PW OM dated 12-5-2017 cited above.**

**2. The Seventh Central Pay Commission (CPC) in Para 10.1.67 & 10.1.68 of its Report had for the first time conceded the long pending demand of the Central Government Pensioners for Parity of Pension between the Pre and Post CPC Pensioners and had recommended the following pension formulation for civil employees including CAPF personnel who had retired before 01.01.2016:**

**i) All the Civilian personnel including CAPF who retired prior to 01.01.2016 (expected date of implementation of the Seventh CPC recommendations) shall first be fixed in the Pay Matrix being recommended by this Commission, on the basis of the Pay Band and Grade Pay at which they retired, at the minimum of the corresponding level in the matrix. This amount shall be raised, to arrive at the notional pay of the retiree, by adding the number of increments he/she had earned in that level while in service, at the rate of three percent. Fifty percent of the total amount so arrived at shall be the revised pension.**

**ii) The second calculation to be carried out is as follows. The pension, as had been fixed at the time of implementation of the VI CPC recommendations, shall be multiplied by 2.57 to arrive at an alternate value for the revised pension.**

**iii) Pensioners be given option of choosing whichever formulation is beneficial to them.**

**3. Option 1, cited above, was very much feasible to implement as recommended by 7<sup>th</sup> CPC for revision of Pension of old Pensioners since according to the survey conducted by the DOP&PW, it was accepted that the Service Records of over 80% of old Pensioners were available, while those of the others could be re-built as per procedure prescribed in the Rules and as was done after 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> CPC and as per orders of the Courts in numerous cases.**

**4. Regrettably, the Committee formed by the Government, to consider the feasibility of implementation of Option 1 recommended by the Seventh CPC, while finding it non-feasible, did not care for the interest of the more than 80% of the Pensioners merely to save the Administration from the botheration of Re-building the Service Records of the rest less than 20% Pensioners. This was a great injustice since the 80% of the Pensioners who's Records are available, shall suffer a loss of Pension just because of missing records of the rest 20%.**

**5. Instead, the Government accepted the following formula vide OM Dated 12-5-2017, as recommended by the Committee on Feasibility of Option 1:**

**“the revised pension/family pension w.e.f. 01.01.2016 in respect of all Central civil pensioners/family pensioners, including CAPF's, who retired/died prior to 01.01.2016, may be revised by notionally fixing their pay in the pay matrix recommended by the 7th CPC in the level corresponding to the pay in the pay scale/pay band and grade pay at which they retired/died. This will be done by notional pay fixation under each intervening Pay Commission based on the Formula for revision of pay. While fixing pay on notional basis the pay fixation formulae approved by the Government and other relevant instructions on the subject in force at the relevant time shall be strictly followed. 50% of the notional pay as on 01.01.2016 shall be the revised pension and 30% of this notional pay shall be the revised family pension w.e.f. 1.1.2016 as per the first Permutation.”**

**6) The above said formula will very seriously and adversely affect the Revised pension of a large majority of the Pre-2016 Pensioners on account of following reasons:**

**a) “Parity of Pension” between Pre and Post-2016 Pensioners - recommended by the Seventh CPC - would be denied to the Pre-2016 Pensioners.**

**b) In the process of notional pay fixation in successive Pay Commissions, there is a lot of dilution particularly for pensioners who retired in 4<sup>th</sup> CPC period resulting in big financial loss.**

**c) Irrespective of the date of retirement, Option 1 would have given the same pension to pre-2016 pensioners depending upon the number of increments earned in the last Level. By denying option 1 there will be sub-groups even within the homogenous group of pre-2016 pensioners.**

**d) None of the above losses would occur to the Pre-2016 Pensioners if the Option 1 recommended by the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC is implemented and if the new formula is allowed as a 3rd Option in addition to Option 1 & 2 Recommended by the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC in the interest of natural justice to all Pre-2016 Pensioners.**

**2. It is, therefore, requested that the Pension of Pre-2016 Pensioners be fixed at the highest of the 3 Options - including first two Options as recommended by 7<sup>th</sup> CPC and 3<sup>rd</sup> Option as accepted by the Government and Notified vide DOP&PW OM Dated 12-5-2017.**

## CONCORDANCE TABLES ISSUED FOR REVISION OF PENSION OF PRE-2016 PENSIONERS AS PER NEW FORMULA OF NOTIONAL FIXATION OF PAY FROM CPC TO CPC & FIXATION OF BASIC PENSION AT 50% OF NOTIONAL PAY OF 7<sup>TH</sup> CPC

**Copy of DOP&PW OM F.No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A) Dated 6th July, 2017**

**Subject:** Revision of pension of pre-2016 pensioners / family pensioners in implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission Concordance tables-regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM of even number dated 12.05.2017 on the above subject and to say that instructions were issued for revision of pension / family pension with effect from 01.01.2016 in respect of Central civil pensioners/family pensioners who retired/died prior to 01.01.2016 by notionally fixing their pay in the pay matrix recommended by the 7th Central Pay Commission in the level corresponding to the pay in the pay scale I pay band and grade pay at which they retired / died. It was provided that 50% of such notional pay shall be the revised pension and 30% of the notional pay shall be the revised family pension w.e.f. 01.01.2016.

2. It was also provided that the revision of pension will be done by notional pay fixation under each intervening Pay Commission based on the formula for revision of pay. Based on the fitment tables provided by the Department of Expenditure, concordance tables for fixation of notional pay and pension/family pension of employees who retired/died in various grades during the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission periods have been prepared and the same are enclosed herewith. In the case of those employees who retired/died before 01.01.1986, these concordance tables may be used based on their notional pay as on 01.01.1986, which was fixed in accordance with this Department's OM No.45/86/97-P&PW(D)(iii) dated 10.02.1998.

3. Separate tables have been given in respect of pre-01.01.2016 pensioners who retired in the Group 'D' pay scales corresponding to 6th CPC grade pay of Rs. 1300/-, Rs. 1400/-, Rs. 1600/- and Rs. 1650/- (Table No. 1 to Table No. 4) and for pensioners who retired during 6<sup>th</sup> CPC period after upgradation to the Grade pay of Rs. 1800/- (Table No. 5 to Table No. 8). The pension/family pension of such pensioners/family pensioners may be revised using the appropriate Table.

4. These concordance tables have been prepared to facilitate revision of pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners by the concerned pension sanctioning authorities. Due care has been taken to prepare these concordance tables based on the fitment tables for fixation of pay from 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission. In case of any inconsistency in the concordance tables vis-à-vis the relevant rules/instructions, the notional pay and pension/family pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners may be fixed in accordance with the rules/instructions applicable for fixation of pay in the intervening Pay Commission periods.

5. It is requested that the pension of pre-2016 pensioners / family pensioners may be revised w.e.f. 01.01.2016 in accordance with the instructions contained in this Department's OM of even No. dated 12.05.2017 and using the concordance tables enclosed herewith.

6. This issues with the approval of Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) vide their Diary No. 1(13)/EV/2017 dated 05.07.2017.

**Sub:** Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission – Revision of pension of pre-2016 Pensioners/family pensioners,

A copy of Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare (DOP&PW)'s O.M. No. 38/37/2016-P&PW(A) dated 12th May, 2017 on the above cited subject is enclosed for information and compliance. These instructions shall apply mutatis mutandis on the Railways also. Rule 40 and 41 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972, mentioned in DOP&PW's O.M., correspond to Rule 64 and 65 of the Railway Services (Pension) Rules, 1993 respectively.

## DOP&PW IMPLEMENTS SC ORDERS FOR RESTORATION OF FULL COMMUTED PENSION OF PSU ABSORBEES WHO HAD TAKEN 100% COMMUTATION OF PENSION

### ORDERS OF RLY. BD. WERE STILL AWAITED EVEN AFTER MORE THAN 2 MONTHS

Culminating a glorious legal battle by PSU Absorbees – spread over more than 25 years in various Courts - DOP&PW had finally implemented Supreme Court Orders for Restoration of full Commuted Pension of those PSU Absorbees who had taken 100% Commutation of Pension vide OM No. F.No.4/34/2002-P&PW(D).Vol.II 21st July, 2017. But orders of the Railway Board were still awaited even after more than 2 months of issue of orders by the DOP&PW. Earlier, only one third of Pension was restored after 15 years of Commutation of 100% Pension by the PSU Absorbees, from 1996 on SC Orders.

This Department had issued orders for implementation of recommendations of 7th CPC for revision of pension of pre-2016 pensioners/ family pensioners, vide this Department's O.Ms mentioned below:

(i) O.M No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A) dated 12.05.2017

(ii) O.M No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A) dated 06.07.2017

2. This Department vide O.M. of even No. dated 25.07.2017 has also emphasised upon all Ministries/Departments etc. to suo-moto proceed to process the revision cases immediately to avoid delays in issuance of revised PPOs of pre-2016 retirees and also send the status of revised cases as on 16.08.2017 in the prescribed proforma so as to reach this Department latest by 31.08.2017.

3. However, it has again come to the notice of this Department that some Ministries/ Departments/Organizations are seeking applications from pre-2016 pensioners/ family pensioners for revision of their pension or asking these pensioners to provide additional information/ documents including PPO, proof of date of birth, date of retirement, name of bank and address etc for the purpose of processing their cases for revision of pension.

4. The Ministries/Department are therefore requested to sensitise the officials dealing with pension cases to suo-moto process the pension revision cases of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners forthwith based on details available with Head of Office/PAOs without insisting submission of any additional information or documents from them.

RISE IN SUBSEQUENTIAL STAGES THEREOF

MINISTRY OF FINANCE (DEPARTMENT OF EXPENDITURE) RESOLUTION NO.1-2/2016-IC. DATED 16.05.2017

Whereas, vide its Resolution No.1-2/2016-IC notified in the Gazette of India, dated the 25th July, 2016, the Government of India accepted the recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission in respect of the categories of employees covered in the Terms of Reference contained in its earlier Resolution No.1/1/2013-E.III(A) dated 28-2-2014.

And, whereas, the Government has considered it necessary to make the following changes in the recommendations of the said Seventh Central Pay Commission in respect of the said categories of employees, namely:—

(1) The Defence Pay Matrix, (except Military Nursing Service (MNS)), which has 24 stages shall be extended to 40 stages similar to the Civil Pay Matrix;

(2) The Index of Rationalisation (IOR) of Level 12A and 13 of Defence Pay Matrix shall be enhanced from 2.57 to 2.67. The Defence Pay Matrix (except MNS) shall, accordingly, be revised;

(3) To rectify the factual errors appearing in Level 10B and Level-12 of the pay matrix of MNS and in view of the changes in the IOR in the Defence Pay Matrix, the first stage of corresponding Levels of Pay Matrix of MNS shall also change. Accordingly, the Pay Matrix (MNS) shall be revised;

(4) The IOR of Level-13 of Civil Pay Matrix shall also be enhanced from 2.57 to 2.67. Accordingly, the Civil Pay Matrix as contained in Annexure-1 mentioned in para 6 of the aforesaid Resolution dated the 25th July, 2016 shall be revised. The revised Civil Pay Matrix is at Appendix-1;

(5) The provision contained in para 13 of the aforesaid Resolution dated 25th July, 2016 shall be revised to the extent that the benefit of pay protection in the form of personal pay of officers posted on deputation under Central Staffing Scheme, as envisaged therein, shall be given effect from 1st January, 2016 instead of 25th July, 2016. Further, this benefit shall also be extended to officers from Services under Central Staffing Scheme, coming on deputation to Central Government, on posts not covered under Central Staffing Scheme.
